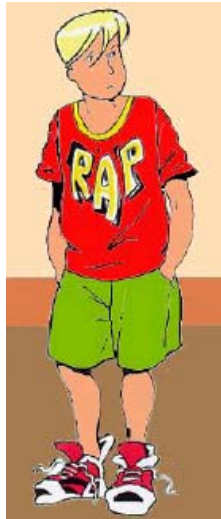

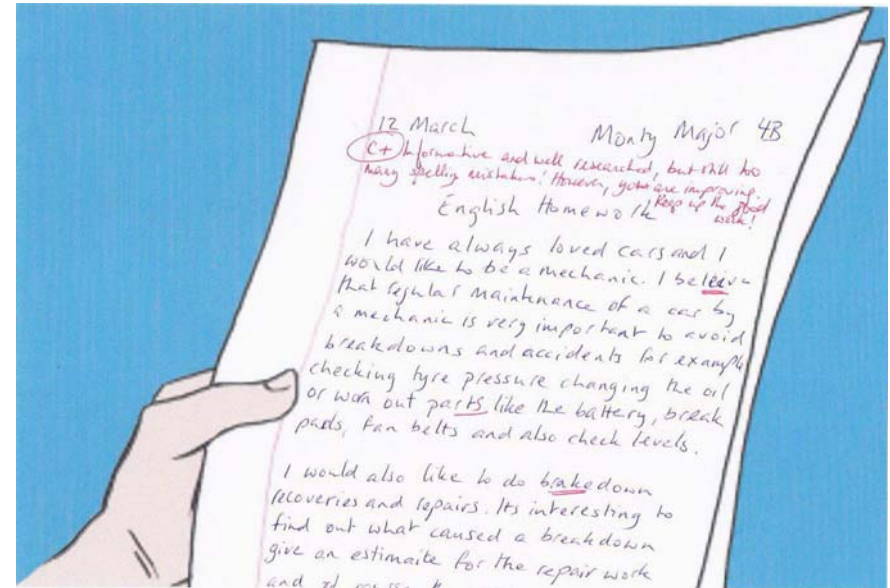

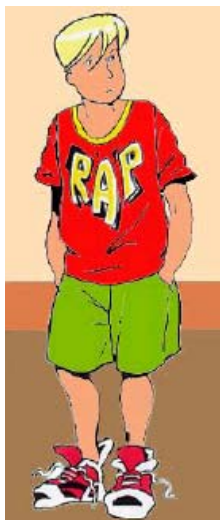
Subject: What job would you like to do when you leave school? ?
